"In granting this sanction/approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Florida Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event".

Conditions of Sanction:

- 1. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- 2. A certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- 3. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and prohibited.
- 4. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA-S Vice President of Program Operations.
- 5. All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

6. COVID Prevention:

In applying for this sanction, the host, Tampa Bay Aquatics, agrees to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines by USA Swimming, Florida Swimming, the State of Florida, and Tampa Preparatory School.

Location: Tampa Preparatory School – 727 W. Cass Street, Tampa, Florida 33606

Type of Meet: 25 Yard, Timed Final

Dates & Times: Saturday, June 1st, 2024 (10:00am Start Time)

*After entries are received one or two sessions will be created based on the number of entries to limit the number of swimmers on deck at any one time. If two sessions are used, we will split 13&Older in the first session and 12&Under in the second session.

Pool Specifications: 4-8 lanes. The numbers of lanes used will be determined based on the number of swimmers entered in the race. 25-yard, outdoor heated/chilled pool, non-turbulent lane lines. Water depth at the competition-starting end is a minimum of 6 feet and the turn end is a minimum of 6 feet.

*Based on the number of entries, we may use 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 lanes for sessions to manage the overall timeline. The remainder of the lanes will be used for warming up and warming down.

Medical Supervision: Lifeguards on duty and 5 AED devices available.

Timing Equipment: Daktronics Electronic Timing Equipment with Scoreboard, Pads and Buttons

Warm Up: If two sessions, the 13&Older session will have 45 minutes of warm-up and the 12&Under session will have 30 minutes of warm-up. Otherwise one 45-minute warm-up. Lane assignment and warm-up procedures will be published after entries are received.

Eligibility: On deck registration will not be allowed. Open to currently registered USA Swimming swimmers.

Event Limit: 3 individual events per day. Entries that exceed the entry limit(s) will automatically be dropped when they exceed the limit for the meet and or day.

Distance Events: Swimmers may only enter 1 of the following events 400IM, 500Fr, 1000Fr and 1650Fr. Coaches are encouraged to only enter swimmers serious about swimming these races for time cuts.

Seeding: Use 25 yard short course times. No Conversion times. All events will be swum as mixed events, scored separately by gender and age groups slowest to fastest. Depending on the number entries we reserve the right to include a 15min break for warming up and warming down.

Scratch Penalty: No penalty for scratches on the block.

Entries: Entries must be in USA Swimming SDIF format sent by email using Hy-Tek team manager or Team Unify. Corrupted, unreadable, or incorrectly formatted files must be corrected within 24 hours. Errors in entries submitted electronically are the responsibility of the applicant. Entries will only be accepted via electronic mail. You may e-mail entries to: jason@tbaynation.com

Scoring: No Scoring for this meet.

Awards: No Awards for this meet.

Team Representative: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach, who will check with the referee about any matter pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. For each team, the coach and that person only will be recognized.

Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during a swim meet or prove current coach membership on Deck Pass.

Camera Zones: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
